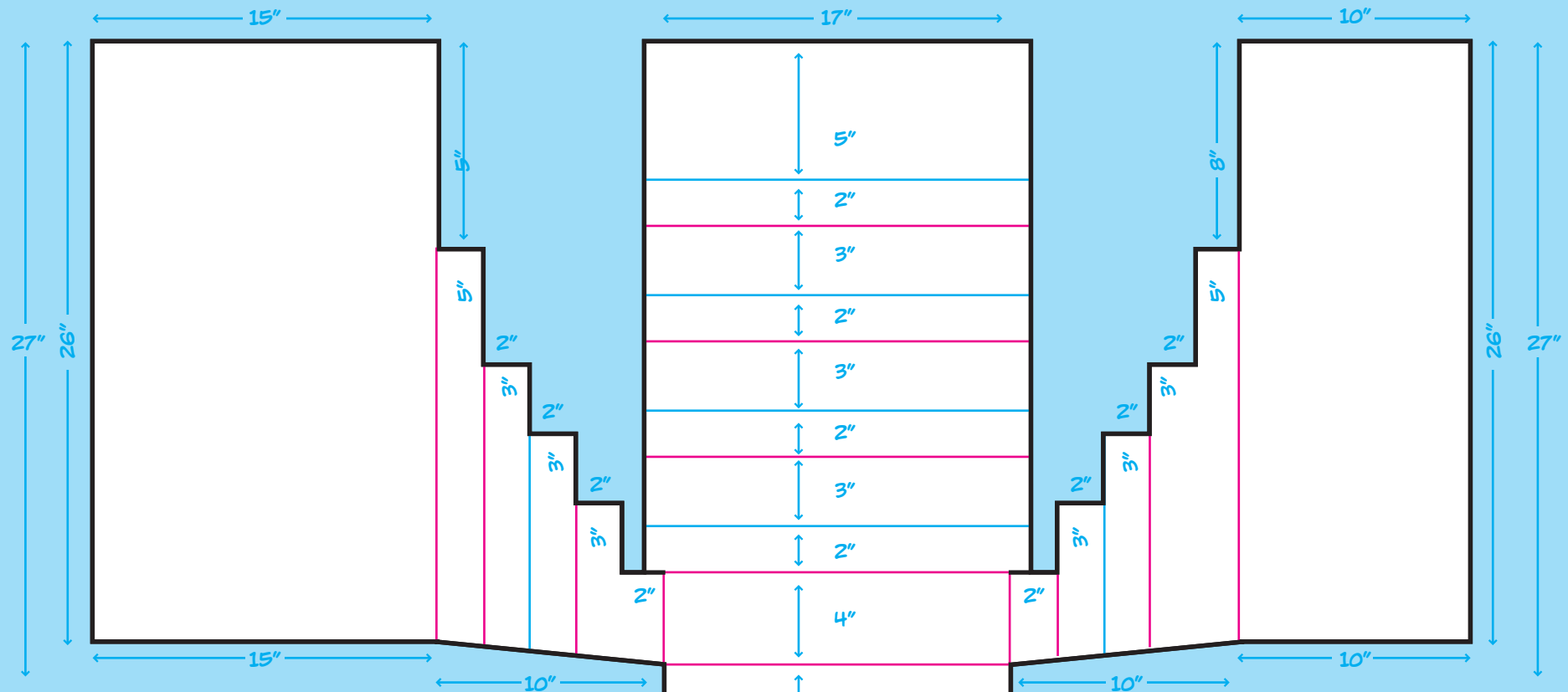


FOAM CORE COMIC DISPLAY STAND

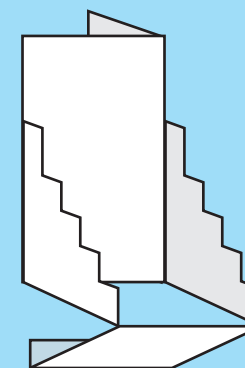

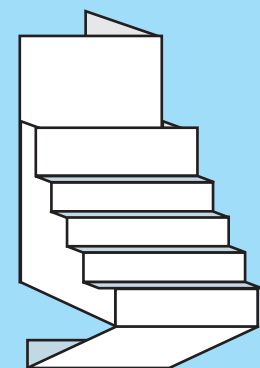
What you'll need: 40" x 60" piece of foam core, utility knife, large ruler, some kind of tape or Velcro.

1. Cut foam core down according to black lines.
2. Score according to red and blue lines. Red lines should be on one side of the board, blue on the reverse (so that the board folds "in" and "out" appropriately).
3. Scores indicated on side "stair" panels will let you fold it down to fit in a suitcase.
4. Fold together. Bottom panel helps keep the side panels keep their shape when scored.
5. Attach back panels with Velcro or tape.
6. Rack will display 8 titles in a 2x4 format. The shelf panel won't initially stay down on it's own, but the books will hold it in place until it does.
